- Judges will evaluate papers on **style** and **content** and will look for writing that is clear, articulate and logically organized.

Student Excellence Awards

The Student Excellence Awards recognize the best all-round future professionals who have shown significant enthusiasm for their profession and who have inspired others to contribute to the development and growth of the professions.

- Selection is based on a **peer nomination process**.
- Student recommendations go to SAC's **Student Representatives**, who forward the top nominees to university faculty advisors.
- University faculty select the final winners based on **clinical ratings**, **leadership qualities** and **grade point average**.
